WHY STRENGTHEN THE SECTOR?

The nonprofit sector is unique – 55,000 public benefit organizations making communities vibrant, innovative and more inclusive places to live, work, and play. Together they contribute \$50 billion to Ontario’s GDP and employ over 1 million people. Harnessing the collective knowledge, leadership, and on-the-ground experience of these inspiring organizations means stronger and thriving Ontario communities for us all.

WHY A PROVINCIAL NETWORK?

ONN plays a unique role in the sector: from public policy development and analysis, to connecting organizations across the province, convening shared opportunities and trends, and channeling collective expertise for solutions-building, ONN is a springboard for sector action. Through our network model, ONN reaches out and engages nonprofits and charities in public policy and advocacy in all parts of Ontario.

A SNAPSHOT OF OUR CURRENT POLICY PRIORITIES

- **Labour force:** Address critical issues affecting the sector’s labour force, such as leadership and skills development, diversity and inclusion, and the need for decent work
- **Funding reform:** Work with the provincial government to improve funding practices and processes, including cost-of-living increases, standard contracts, greater access to government funding
- **Social enterprise:** Advocate for policy and legislative changes to create an enabling environment for nonprofit social enterprise
- **Regulatory environment:** Identify policy and regulatory changes to enable and support the development and growth of shared platform approaches, as well as advocate for the Ontario Not-for-Profit Corporations Act to be proclaimed

HIGHLIGHTS

NETWORK ADVANCES

- We continued our work with nonprofits and funders to create a **Sector Driven Evaluation Strategy**
- We mobilized a Pensions Task Force to provide sector-driven recommendations for a **pension plan for all nonprofits**
- We worked with the sector to share tools and resources to **help our sector integrate accessibility** into its culture
- We collaborated on an idea to streamline transfer payment agreements for **community hubs**, leading to an Open Government design lab
- We finished the first phase of our **Decent Work** project, producing a framework that identifies how the sector can foster conditions for decent work
