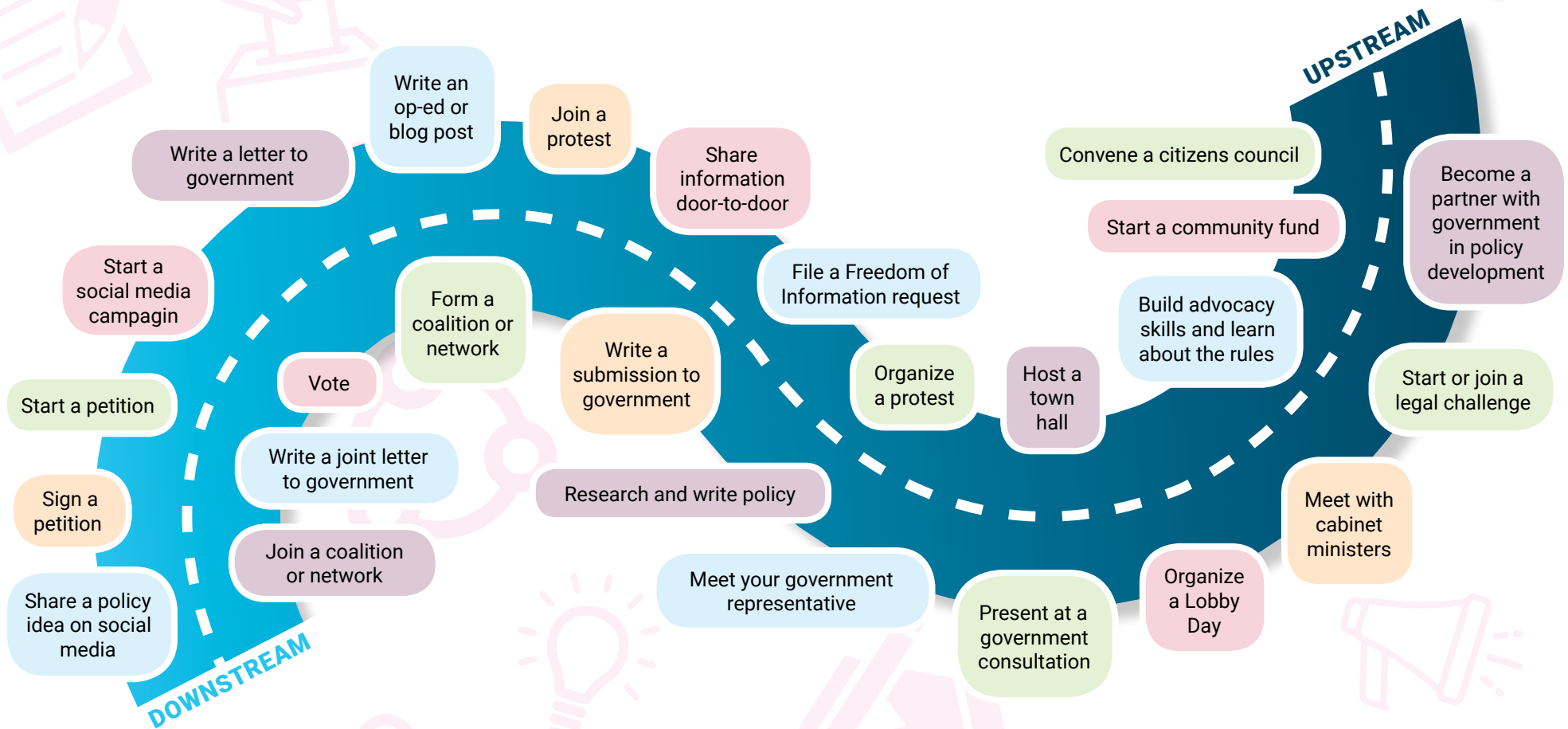

ADVOCACY SPECTRUM

HOW IT WORKS

The Advocacy Spectrum outlines a number of actions organizations and individuals can take to make effective policy change. No one action is sufficient on its own, nor is one necessarily better than another to influence and make policy change happen.



There may be other actions to add, too. Feel free to make it your own! And keep in mind that advocacy and this spectrum are not linear - actions could move around from side to side.



The spectrum could also be used to map out where other organizations are advocating on the same issue. Where are the overlaps and where are the gaps in influencing decision makers?



There's a place for everyone on the spectrum. It can depend on personal or organizational capacity, energy, values, and understanding of specific issues. It can also change at different times and for different issues.



The key is to find your place and work with others at different parts of the spectrum to build the change for healthy and inclusive communities.

Dimensions to advocacy to consider

UPSTREAM/DOWNSTREAM:

Downstream: Reacting to government decisions and actions to make necessary changes

Upstream: Thinking of ideas to make positive social change and taking steps to make it happen

INDIVIDUAL/COLLECTIVE:

Individual: Actions you can take on your own

Collective: Actions that groups can take, working together or on their own
